MAR 19 **HYT H1 The Hydromechanical Horologists ... BASELWORLD 2012:**

The cases are in solid 18 carat rose-gold or titanium. The diameter: 48.8 mm and the thickness: 17.9 mm. The watch has a cambered sapphire crystal with glareproofed interior and a screw-down sapphire back. The "engine" of the timepiece is an exclusive HYT calibre with 28,800 vph (4 Hz). It has 35 jewels and bridges hand-chamfered and adorned with Côtes de Genève decoration. The movement has a 65-hour power reserve.

The two reservoirs at 06:00 are the keys here. While the first compresses, the second expands, and the other way round, resulting in the movement of the liquid in the capillary.

As the hours go by, the fluorescent liquid advances. Up till now, seven patents have been registered for the technology and one for the design.

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
