Among the new ventures in the watchmaking world are exploration into multi-dimensional watches, watches that offer unusual games on them, watches that have a symbiotic relationship to their wearer, and watches that incorporate water in their displays. Indeed, by pulling out all the stops when it comes to creativity in design, today's brands are stopping people in their tracks.

HYT is all about Hydro-Mechanical Horology. The brand, which made its debut in 2012 with the HYT H1, uses liquid time display. The watch features bellows (like car pistons) that are filled with a liquid. When the wearer wishes to indicate the time, the bellows are compressed and the fluid moves into veins that surround the dial. As the veins fill with fluid, they indicate the hours and minutes. The mechanical manual wind watch is truly innovative, especially now that the brand has turned to new materials for its recently announced new version: the HYT H1 Azo, which features an ultra-light alloy for the case with fluorescent yellow green fluid.

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
