H1 RED2

Movement: Mechanical, exclusive HYT caliber; manual-winding; 28,800vph; 65-hour power reserve; 35 jewels

Functions: Retrograde red fluidic hours; minutes, seconds

Case: Titanium with shot-peened and satin-finished surfaces, brushed 5N pink gold bezel and lugs; 48.8mm; water resistant to 100m

Dial: Unstructured; gray dial, 5N pink gold indices, numerals and minute hand; regulator at 12:00, small seconds at 9:30, power reserve indicator at 2:30

Strap: Gray rubber; matching pin buckle

Limitation: 50 pieces

H2

Movement: Mechanical, exclusive HYT caliber developed with APRP; manual-winding; 21,600vph; 192-hour (8-day) power reserve; 28 jewels

Functions: Retrograde fluidic hours; minutes with jumping hand ("déphaseur angulaire") at 30 minutes; crown position indicator (H-N-R); temperature indicator

Case: Black DLC titanium with polished, microblasted and satin finishes; 48.8mm; water resistant to 50m

Dial: Sapphire minute dial

Strap: Rubber; matching deployment buckle

Terrascope Black DLC

Movement: JRD caliber, self-winding, 28,800vph, ~30 hour power reserve

Functions: Hours, minutes, seconds, date

Case: Sandblasted and vertically satin finished black DLC-coated stainless steel, 44mm, black case back

Dial: Black, grained, luminescent hands and markers

Strap: Black rubber, folding buckle
